







2018 Lecture & Hands-on Workshop Extraction Socket Management

A half-day Hands-on course for General Dental Practitioners

This workshop will explore the concept of site preservation following tooth extraction. The course is aimed specifically at augmentation of extraction sockets at the time of tooth extraction as a means of preserving hard and soft tissue profile prior to either implant tooth replacement or restoration with a bridge pontic. This unique course will offer practical step-by-step instruction on how to manage tooth extractions properly and reduce the chance of loss of labial plate and soft tissue collapse post tooth extraction. Socket augmentation assists in providing more predictable aesthetics for patients receiving tooth supported bridges or dental implant tooth replacement in the aesthetic zone.

This course includes detailed instruction of atraumatic tooth extraction, including the use of luxators, periotomes, and surgical removal of tooth roots and preservation of the extraction socket. Clinical assessment & case selection, post-operative management will be covered as will discussion on the type of socket graft material and barrier membranes to use. The course will be hands-on with participants using the pig jaw model to complete clinical exercises. This will allow you to experience the handling properties of the materials and clinical techniques necessary to incorporate this into your daily clinical practice.

About the presenter: Dr Michael Danesh-Meyer is a Specialist Periodontist and is Director at the Institute of Dental Implants & Periodontics in Newmarket, Auckland. Prior to establishing the institute Dr Danesh-Meyer was a Clinical Assistant Professor and Research Assistant in the Department of Periodontology at Temple University, School of Dentistry in Philadelphia, USA. He has taught implant dentistry and periodontics at postgraduate level and has authored numerous scientific articles, is a key opinion leader for a number of dental supply companies and lectures both nationally and internationally on implant dentistry and tissue regenerative therapy.
